To uphold and advance the honour, integrity and high standards of the
Optical dispensing profession, its members must:

- a) Be honest and impartial in serving the public and the profession,**
- b) Strive to increase the competence and prestige of the profession,**
- c) Keep abreast of technical and educational advancements in the
Optical dispensing field,**
- d) Respect the dignity and professional status of their colleagues
and the professional relationship between their colleagues and
the public,**
- e) Use their knowledge and skills to improve the health and
wellbeing of the public,**
- f) Protect the health of the public at all times by delegating duties
or procedures only to a person who is qualified by training AND
Registered with the Association as a person able to perform that
duty or procedure,**
- g) Fulfill all medically based instructions of the Optometrist/
Ophthalmologist and do everything possible in conjunction with
him/her to conserve human eyesight.**
