Council update

Save the date: Online AGM— April 23, 2023 more info. to come.

The Province submitted the names of two applicants for the vacant position of OANB second Public Member. Council expressed interest in a bilingual Fredericton lawyer, whose skills and experience would be serve OANB well. We'll keep you posted!

Council is working on an general Regulations review to ensure our Regula-tions are relevant, clear and up-to-date. This work is timely, as we help the Learning for the new NBCC Optical Program as they develop their curriculum for their Sept. 2023 launch.

In consultation with other Canadian Opticianry Regulators, NACOR and the Registrars of the other NB Healthcare Associations/Colleges, Council is working on amending the practical hour requirements for Apprentices, as all Optical Programs, no matter how differently they are deliv-ered, must meet the strict competency requirements of Accreditation Canada.

This amendment and other lesser changes to the Regulations, mostly for the purpose of improved clarity, will be purpose of improved clarity, will be reviewed by our lawyer to ensure all revisions are legally correct. The amend-ments will then be sent to members as a Motion with a 14-day response period, before Council reviews responses and approves or rejects the motion. The final and if approved in time, the changes can be ratified at the 2023 AGM.
