It allows OANB to legally exist and gives it power to govern the profession of Opticianry in the Province of New Brunswick, within the law. The Act cannot be changed without the agreement of all stakehold-

ers and legislative approval. Objects of the Act are: (a) to ensure to the public the proficiency and

(b) to maintain a high standard of professional ethics among opticians;
